# Set-up Instructions for H-WASH 45

Please ensure that you read these instructions and follow every step to create your H-WASH 45 hand-wash station.



## Step 1

Unpack your unit and ensure that it is placed on stable ground. Fix through the base if necessary to secure the unit to the ground. Do not put any fixings through the grey sink unit



## Step 4

To fill the unit with consumables unlock the dispenser from beneath it and push upwards.



## Step 5

Fill the paper towel dispenser on the left of the unit and put your spare towels in the storage compartment behind. Attached the soap dispenser to the top of your 5L soap container, and insert upside-down into the dispenser unit.



## Step 2

Check that the waste water pipe is inserted into the waste water container in the rear of the unit, and that the bin is in place.



## Step 6

Ensure you check the waste water container regularly throughout each day, and empty at least once per day. Ensure you empty into a sewer drain. Please note that the waste water is 25L and will need emptying twice, for every clean water tank refill.



## Step 3

Unscrew the filler cap on the top of the sink, and fill the unit with water. Ensure you do not exceed the maximum fill level indicated on the front of the unit.



## Step 7

Ensure you refresh the clean water in the sink unit at least once a week. Carry out a daily cleaning routine on the actual sink unit, using Anti-bacterial cleaning spray.
